

**Millcreek Township Trustees  
Public Hearing  
January 4, 2010**

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio convened in special session from 6:30 p.m. until 6:45 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building. Mr. Lynch called the meeting to order to review the 2010 Supplement to the Millcreek Township Land Use Growth Plan with the following members present:

**MEMBERS:** Mr. Lynch, Mr. Conroy, Mr. Jordan and Mrs. Beaver.

**VISITORS:** Bill Schrader and Jim Schrader.

The Millcreek Township Zoning Commission approved the 2010 Supplement to the Millcreek Township Land Use Growth Plan and forwarded their recommendation to the trustees. LUC also made 17 recommendations on the supplement and most of those recommendations were addressed.

Bill Schrader made several comments about the supplement –

- Land owners should be included in land preservation discussions.
- The burden of single rural homes is more significant than homes in a housing development.
- Only 10 percent of the homes in Millcreek Township are located on land used for agricultural purposes.

Mr. Conroy responded that most of Mr. Schrader's concerns were addressed in the supplement.

Mr. Lynch also responded the Land Use Growth Plan is a guiding document for township officials.

Mr. Lynch thanked the zoning board, former trustee Marian Jacques and current trustees for their input and time spent developing the supplement to the land use growth plan.

- **Resolution #816:** motion that the trustees accept the Zoning Commission recommendation to adopt the 2010 Supplement to the Land Use Growth Plan by Mr. Conroy, seconded by Mr. Jordan.
- Motion unanimously approved.

All formal actions of the Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of resolutions and or motions passed at this meeting were adopted in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Resolution #817:** motion to adjourn by Mr. Lynch, seconded by Mr. Jordan.
