

**Millcreek Township Trustees
Special Session
March 9, 2015**

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio convened in special session from 6:30 p.m. until 7:35 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building for the Millcreek Township US 42 Thoroughfare Study stakeholder meeting. Mr. Lynch called the meeting to order with the following members present:

MEMBERS: Mr. Lynch, Mr. Conroy, Mr. Jordan, and Mrs. Beaver.

ATTENDEES: Kim Burton and Jon Miller - Burton Planning Services, Jeff Stauch and Bill Narducci – Union County Engineer’s Office, and Kevin Bryant.

Millcreek Township is partnering with the Union County Engineer’s Office, and ODOT to conduct an eastern Union County US 42 Thoroughfare Study. Members from the consulting firm, Burton Planning Services and the Union County Engineer’s Office met with township officials to discuss the goals and needs of the township in reference to a study of US 42. Millcreek Township wants to be proactive in preparing for the ability to handle existing and future traffic along US 42 in a safe and effective manner due to the growth of businesses and residential areas along that corridor.

The trustees requested the study produce guidelines for future changes to the US 42 roadway network that can be incorporated into the Millcreek Township Zoning Resolution. A public meeting will be scheduled in mid-summer to gain insight from the community and present preliminary drafts of the study.
