

Millcreek Township Trustees
Open House
August 8, 2017

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio along with the Millcreek Township Zoning Commission held a public open house at 7:00 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building to provide residents with an overview of the proposed drafted update to the Millcreek Township Land Use/Growth Plan.

Mr. Lynch explained background information on why the trustees had decided to update the current Land Use/Growth Plan and noted the Plan is a tool to guide township officials. The Township is not seeking development but wants to be in a position to control development if approached by a developer.

Mr. Conroy introduced Jamie Greene and Kyle May from Planning Next. Mr. Greene and Mr. May led the presentation of material to reveal major findings from the update process, review the community's vision and values, unveil the general and planning area recommendations, review the existing plan, and provide feedback. There have been many planning sessions with the Millcreek Township Trustees, Zoning Board, and Board of Zoning Appeals, Mr. Greene, and Mr. May. The task of Mr. Greene and Mr. May was to collect information from the planning sessions and combine the information into an easy to use document.

Eleven display boards with additional information were exhibited in the room. Attendees were encouraged to read the display boards and provide written feedback to reflect concerns. Feedback will be used to refine the Plan and prepare the document for adoption by the trustees.
