Millcreek Township Trustees Regular Meeting Minutes June 3, 2024

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio convened in regular session from 7:00 p.m. to 8:50 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building for the monthly meeting. Mr. Conroy called the meeting to order with the following members present:

Meeting Minutes

Mr. Conroy asked for a motion to approve the regular monthly meeting minutes from May 6, 2024.

- **Resolution #2465:** motion to approve the minutes of the May 6, 2024 regular meeting by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Long.
- Motion unanimously approved.

Jerome Township Fire Department

Chief Stewart presented the monthly fire/EMS stats for May and other notable highlights for the department.

- Chief Stewart introduced to the trustees other members of his Fire & EMS staff who were also in attendance at the meeting. Chief Stewart wants the township trustees and residents to have the opportunity to meet other members of the team by having them attend township meetings periodically.
- Responses through May 2024 have increased by approximately 12% as compared to last year.
- Delivery of the new Medic Unit is expected in July.
- Delivery of the new Tanker is still on schedule for Fall 2025.
- Chief Stewart is inquiring about the cost of new/additional tornado sirens for the townships and any grants available to pay for them. He will gather additional information and share more with the trustees at a later date.

Union County Sheriff's Office

Deputy Phelan did not have anything specific to report to the trustees regarding patrol or traffic activity. Deputy Phelan notified the trustees that he is being transferred to patrol a different location for a temporary period of time, but the Sheriff's Office will be filling his PSO role within Jerome and Millcreek Townships with another Deputy right away.

Public Comment

Rick Ruggles inquired as to whether any plans were being developed to provide a new access driveway from Brown Road to the soccer fields located on Watkins Road. The trustees are not aware of any plans for a new access driveway from Brown Road.

Joanne Rausch voiced concern regarding the condition of a property near the intersection of Harriott Road and Bell Road.

Zoning

Zoning Commission

Joni Orders, Zoning Commission Chair, was unable to attend today's meeting. The Zoning Commission met on May 21st. Representatives from Planning NEXT provided an introductory presentation to the Commission members regarding the work beginning to review the township's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code. Planning NEXT will be holding a meeting open to the public on June 18th. The Zoning Commission's regular monthly meeting was rescheduled to June 25th as a result.

Board of Zoning Appeals

No updates.

Zoning Administrator

Ron Todd, Zoning Administrator, provided updates to the trustees.

- The annual inspection of the property at 12140 Watkins Road was conducted on April 25th. Mr. Todd presented the inspection report to the trustees and provided an overview of each matter inspected and the findings. The trustees asked questions throughout Mr. Todd's presentation of the inspection report.
- Mr. Todd also provided updates regarding zoning violation inquiries and notices that he is following up on.
- **Resolution #2466:** motion to accept the Zoning Administrator's report for May 2024 by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Long.
- Motion unanimously approved.

Trustees

Union County Engineer's Office

The trustees reviewed a proposal provided by the Union County Engineer's Office at last month's meeting for maintenance and repairs to access roads at Watkins Cemetery.

- **Resolution #2467:** motion to approve the estimate of \$2,435.03 to perform maintenance and repairs (regrading) to access roads at Watkins Cemetery and authorize the Union County Engineer to undertake and perform the work by Mr. Conroy, seconded by Mr. Long.
- Motion unanimously approved.

Garage Concrete Floor

The trustees reviewed contractor quotes to pour a concrete floor inside the township garage. The trustees also discussed approving the cost of the concrete floor as an authorized expenditure from the American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") funds previously received.

- **Resolution** #2468: motion to hire Big Z Concrete LLC to install a concrete floor within the township garage per the specs included in the vendor's written quote at a cost not to exceed \$17,275.00 by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Long.
- Motion unanimously approved.
- **Resolution** #2469: motion to authorize the cost of installing a concrete floor within the township garage, not to exceed \$17,275.00, be paid for from ARPA Funds (having elected to use the standard allowance and its presumption of revenue loss due to the public health emergency) by Mr. Conroy, seconded by Mr. Long.
- Motion unanimously approved.

Mr. Jordan

- Spraying for weeds around the township grounds was completed recently.
- No further updates regarding projects other than those already discussed during this meeting.

Mr. Long

- No updates regarding the cemetery software.
- Mr. Long will request information and pricing for new tables and chairs from the vendor used by Fairbanks Schools.
- The flagpole outside the township hall was fixed recently.

Mr. Conroy

- The 33 Corridor Committee is scheduled to meet again in June.
- As previously discussed with the Zoning Commission, Planning NEXT will be holding a meeting open to the public on June 18th to gather community feedback and to review the results of the community survey.
