### Millcreek Township Trustees Regular Meeting Minutes June 7, 2021

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio convened in regular session from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building for the monthly meeting. Mr. Conroy called the meeting to order with the following members present:

## **Meeting Minutes**

Mr. Conroy asked for a motion to approve the regular monthly meeting minutes from May 3, 2021.

- **Resolution #2176:** motion to approve the minutes of the May 3, 2021 regular meeting by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Long.
- Motion unanimously approved.

Mr. Conroy asked for a motion to approve the public hearing minutes from May 3, 2021.

- **Resolution #2177:** motion to approve the minutes of the May 3, 2021 public hearing by Mr. Long, seconded by Mr. Jordan.
- Motion unanimously approved.

## Jerome Township Fire Department

Chief Stewart presented the monthly fire/EMS stats for May and other notable highlights for the department.

- No noteworthy activity within the monthly Fire & EMS responses.
- Mull & Weithman, an architecture firm in Columbus, was selected to be the architects to design the new fire station. Jerome Village is working with Jerome Township regarding transferring property ownership and any necessary zoning details so that the construction of the new fire station can occur when ready.
- Fire engine 210 has been out of service due to mechanical issues.

## **Union County Sheriff's Office**

Deputy Payton spoke as a representative of the PSO program and provided a brief update. They have dealt with more traffic accidents and stops of impaired drivers recently. High traffic areas like US 42, Watkins Road and Watkins-California Road continue to be prioritized for patrolling.

Chief Deputy Morgan stated they talked with the construction crew working at US 42 and US 33 regarding the truck sitting close to the entrance ramp and roadway. The Sheriff's Office asked that the truck be moved further away from the road and entrance ramp to provide better visibility for drivers. This will be monitored from time to time to ensure compliance with their request.

### Police / Public Safety Officer Services Levy

Prior to the meeting, Chief Deputy Morgan emailed the trustees projected cost estimates of the PSO program for the years 2022 through 2026. Discussion was held by the trustees regarding the benefits and costs of the PSO program and whether or not to place a levy on the November 2021 ballot to continue funding the PSO program for Millcreek Township. The current levy is set to expire at the end of 2021.

- **Resolution #2178:** motion for a resolution of necessity to place a 2.15 mill replacement levy for police & public safety officer services by the Union County Sheriff's Office for 5 years beginning in 2022 on the November ballot by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Long.
- Motion unanimously approved.

## **Public Comment**

A parent affiliated with the Ostrander Summer Ball Association inquired about scheduling practice time and games for a travel baseball team at the township ball field.

She would like more field time for practicing and would like to schedule games/tournaments. Field improvements would be necessary to schedule games there, but she said the team might be open to completing the improvements themselves, possibly in lieu of the rental fee. The trustees voiced concerns about completing field improvements and the ongoing maintenance but will talk with her after the meeting about what field time is available to schedule.

## <u>Zoning</u>

## Zoning Commission

Ms. Joni Orders, Zoning Commission Chair, provided updates to the trustees.

- The Zoning Commission held its regular monthly meeting on May 18<sup>th</sup>.
- A revised version of the draft language for the overlay district (US33 and US42 Corridor) was reviewed in detail. Comments and suggested changes will be sent to our external consultant, the LUC and the Union County Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for review. The group is moving closer to scheduling public meetings during the next few months to receive the public's feedback.

# Board of Zoning Appeals

## Zoning Administrator

Mr. Ron Todd emailed the Zoning Administrator report to the trustees for review prior to the meeting.

- The LUC distributed an updated Agricultural Exemption Form to review.
- Mr. Todd updated the trustees on various township activities he has been involved with or heard about, including permits, lot splits and updated CUP's
- Mr. Todd updated the trustees on recent code enforcement activities, including tall grass notices.
- Davisson property annual inspection Mr. Todd presented his 2021 Inspection Report regarding the property at 12140 Watkins Road. Some compliance violations were noted during the inspection. Mr. Davisson has been notified and will be given time to remediate the violations. Follow-up will occur once the remediation time has expired. Mr. Day and Mr. Mansfield, township residents, asked questions to Mr. Todd regarding the report. The trustees noted the report was prepared thoroughly and appreciated Mr. Todd's efforts pulling it together.
