

**Millcreek Township Trustees
Special Session
March 7, 2016**

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio convened in special session from 6:00 p.m. until 6:55 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building for a public meeting to review the results of the US 42 Thoroughfare Study. Mr. Conroy called the meeting to order with the following members present:

MEMBERS: Mr. Lynch, Mr. Conroy, Mr. Jordan, and Mrs. Beaver.

ATTENDEES: Jeff Stauch and Bill Narducci – Union County Engineer’s Office, Kevin Bryant.

In 2014, ODOT began a study of US Route 42 from London, Ohio to Delaware, Ohio. Millcreek Township partnered with the Union County Engineer’s Office, and ODOT to conduct an eastern Union County US 42 Thoroughfare Study in 2015. A major factor in deciding to conduct an eastern Union County US 42 Thoroughfare Study revolved around the ability to use data collected by the 2014 study conducted by ODOT. Members from the consulting firm, Burton Planning Services, were involved in both studies. Representatives from Burton Planning Services, the Union County Engineer’s Office, township officials, and residents to discuss the goals and needs of the township in reference to a study of US 42. Millcreek Township wants to be proactive in preparing for the ability to handle existing and future traffic along US 42 in a safe and effective manner due to the growth of businesses and residential areas along that corridor.

Results of the US 42 Thoroughfare Study will be used in the future by the Union County Engineer’s Office and Millcreek Township as a tool when the entity is approached by developers. The US 42 corridor is one of the fastest growing areas in Ohio with a high percentage of truck traffic. Goals of the study were to improve public safety, to keep traffic flowing, to provide necessary and safe access to business, and to ensure development is consistent for the Route 42 corridor.
