Millcreek Township Trustees Regular Meeting Minutes May 2, 2016

The Millcreek Township Trustees of Union County, Ohio convened in regular session from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Millcreek Township Community Building for the monthly meeting. Mr. Lynch called the meeting to order with the following members present:

Receipts

Business

Mr. Lynch asked for a motion to approve the meeting minutes of the monthly meeting held on April 4, 2016.

Award Presentation

The trustees presented Lt. Dave Wilson a plaque to commend his years of service as the Millcreek Township Fire Prevention Officer. Mr. Conroy recognized Lt. Wilson's dedication and involvement in the community.

Police Protection, PSO, Levy

The current levy for additional police protection, PSO, expires in 2016. There was discussion about placing a levy for the PSO on the November, 2016 ballot.

- **Resolution #1589:** motion for a resolution of necessity to place a 2.15 mill replacement police protection from the Union County Sheriff's Department for 5 years on the November ballot by Mr. Conroy, seconded by Mr. Lynch.
- Motion unanimously approved.

Delaware Street

Assistant Prosecutor Gray and Mr. Honsey discussed the challenges the Township may face in the future if Delaware Street is vacated. The church located on Delaware Street only has road frontage to Delaware Street. Adjoining property owners have agreed to issue an easement to the church if the street is vacated, however PA Gray stated the lack of road frontage for the church would set a precedent in the township.

Ball Field Lights

Mr. Jordan received a proposal from Area Energy & Electric for \$1,812.00 to cover the light pole bases on the ball field.

- **Resolution #1590:** motion to contract with Area Energy & Electric, not to exceed \$1,812.00, to cover the light pole bases around the Millcreek Township ball field and to disconnect and remove wire in the electrical panel that feeds to the pole light bases in the ball field by Mr. Lynch, seconded by Mr. Conroy.

Mr. Honsey submitted the Zoning Administrator's report for April.

- **Resolution #1591:** motion to accept the ZA report as submitted for April by Mr. Lynch, seconded by Mr. Jordan.

Mr. Honsey reported he has made the annual inspection of the property. The report will be forthcoming.

Zoning Commission

The Zoning Commission met in April and decided to table the zoning resolution text changes until the Millcreek Comprehensive Plan has been updated.
